Leisure Package:

Traditional Harbour Cruise: Cruise around the two natural harbours on either side of Valletta - Marsamxett Harbour and the Grand Harbour. A detailed commentary will unfold the history of Valletta and the Three Cities connected with two Great Sieges of 1565 and 1942, as well as all the other places of interest including the historical forts, battlements and creeks which can only be admired from the sea.

Malta Sightseeing Bus Tour: An exhilarating open top, hop-on hop-off, bus journey visiting the important sites and attractions.

Wine Tasting Tour: The tour, which takes place at the Cellars, commences with a historical introduction amongst original artifacts, followed by an explanation about the process of how the locally grown grapes are pressed, fermented and eventually transformed into Wine. The visit to the 'Ageing Cellars' is a walk through the 400-year-old Cellars, which are authentic and true to Maltese heritage.

Valletta: 'A City built by gentlemen for gentlemen is Malta's capital city: a living, working city by the administrative and commercial heart of the island. You will visit: The City Gate, Upper Barrakka Gardens, Auberge de Castle and you have the opportunity to explore other interesting parts of the capital.

Mdina + Rabat: The history of Mdina and its suburb Rabat is as old and as fascinating as the history of Malta itself. Mdina, Malta's medieval capital City, can trace its origins back more than 4000 years. We will visit: Rabat—Suburbs of Mdina, tour around the fortified city, Panoramic views, Main gate and Greek gate and free time allocated.

3 Cities Vintage Bus: The Three Cities tour commences with a drive through Senglea, then to Cospicua and finally up to Vittoriosa. The city of Vittoriosa, known by the Maltese as Birgu, retains many interesting buildings including the early Auberges of the Knights, their hospital, the Armory, the Treasury and palaces connected with the Order's administration.

Traditional Maltese Market: Marsaxlokk picturesque fishing village has the most popular Sunday market, where you can buy anything from fish to fruit to Malta lace, nougat, sweets and more.
